4.1. Bradford City of Culture 2025

IC reported that DB,PH,RS and DJ have volunteered for the sub group. As yet no further progress can be made until the results of the bids are approved.

4.2. Primary School Photo Archive session.

IC reported that the session had to be abandoned as the Bradford Education firewalls prevented access to sites containing 'photos'. DJ commented that a similar problem occurred in 2023. However, the school IT technician succeeded in changing the settings to grant access to the photo archive. A new date is to be scheduled.
